At St. Dominic School, the health and safety of our students, staff, and families is our number one priority. To ensure that the 2021-2022 school year creates a safe environment for all, we need to work together to maintain a safe school. While we are starting the school year with recommended masking for unvaccinated individuals, there are other safety protocols that must be followed to help keep us safe. Please note, that if it becomes necessary to require masking for all, the school will notify families as soon as possible.

Responsibilities of St. Dominic School

- Maintain a 3' -6' distance in the classroom
- Maintain a 3' distance at lunch tables
- Require frequent handwashing
- Provide hand sanitizer throughout the building
- Frequent sanitizing of common areas in the school
- End of day sanitizing of all classrooms
- Follow parent direction on masking their child at school
- Follow MDH Decision tree when a student exhibits symptoms at school
- Require students to test and quarantine as directed by MDH

Responsibilities of Students/Families

- Keep children home when showing symptoms on MDH Decision Tree
- Contact the school if/when a child shows symptoms on the MDH Decision Tree, anyday/anytime
- Contact the school immediately when anyone in the family is exposed to a confirmed positive case of COVID, anyday/anytime
- Frequent handwashing
- Provide a clean mask each day *(if elected to wear at school)*
- Provide a clean water bottle each day
- Try to limit exposure to germs outside of the school
- Wear a mask when riding district busing to and from school
