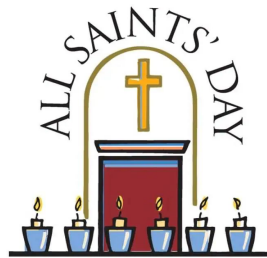
Our second grant is from the Catholic Community Foundation for \$8,400 to purchase new signage around the school and new marketing signage to promote our school at church.
