Tuesday, May 31

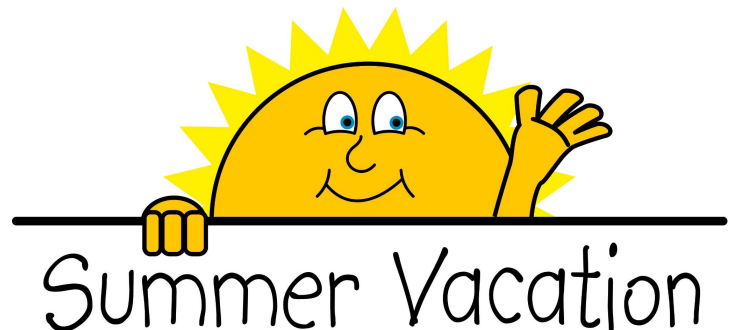
