Lunch for 2022-2023

School Lunches this year will no longer be free through the Federal Lunch Program. The cost is \$3 per lunch, \$1.50 per second entree at lunch, and \$.50 per snack milk. Preschool and Pre-K do not have milk at snack and for our Kindergarten students, snack milk is free through the federal program.

Your TADS account will be charged at the end of each month for the lunches, second lunches and snack milk. This is due by the 15th of each month.
