Pick Up and Drop Off Routines

Important reminders!

There are only two lanes for driving through our parking lot. Do not create a center lane for driving, this is dangerous for our students and parents. There will be two cones near the Parish Office signaling where cars should stop to drop off or pick up their child. Please move up to the cones to prevent a backup on to St. Olaf Avenue.

- **Left Lane is for moving**
- **Right Lane is for stopping**
- **Parking Lot-** If you will walk your child up to the door, or pick them up from the door, you must park in the middle spaces of our lot, not near the basketball hoops.

In the afternoon, Preschool and PreK parents should meet their child's teacher and class just outside the front door of the school. For K-8 students, Mr. Bornhauser will be in the school parking lot during afternoon pick up to ensure that students make it safely to their car.
