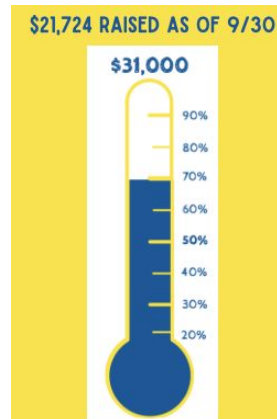

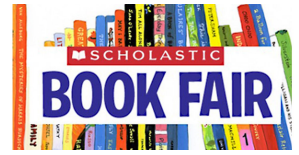
Strategic Plan Update 2022-2023
