Principal's Corner

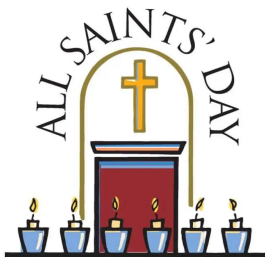

St. Dominic School is partnering with Rice County Public Health (RCPH) to provide an Influenza and Covid Booster Vaccine Clinic in Northfield.

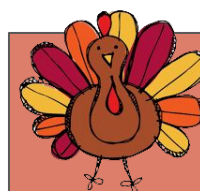

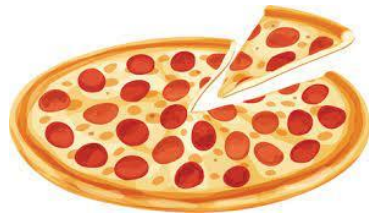
Ofrenda for Dia de Los Muertos
