Grounding Skills

JAN

Grounding skills are exercises that can help you refocus on the present moment to help de-escalate big emotions. Grounding skills can help us feel calm, rather than focusing on thoughts and feelings that are

distressing.



One example of grounding is the 5-4-3-2-1 skill. For this skill you engage your 5 senses to bring yourself to the present moment, rather than focusing on the distressing or negative thoughts are occurring. To practice this skill, take a look at the picture to the right! You can do a grounding exercise anywhere and anytime. It helps to have:

- A quiet, comfortable place
- A few minutes when you won't be interrupted
