Winter NWEA MAP testing begins soon.

Dear St. Dominic School Parent/Guardian,

During the next few weeks, your child will take a MAP® Growth™ test from NWEA® on an iPad (K-4) or a Chromebook (grades 5-8). Teachers will conduct testing sessions in the

classroom. MAP Growth scores help teachers check student performance by measuring achievement and growth. Teachers use results to tailor classroom lessons and set goals for students.

MAP Growth tests are unique and adapt to your child's responses to measure your child's knowledge. If your child answers a question correctly, the next question is more challenging. If they answer incorrectly, the next one is easier. These results will provide a more complete picture of where your child is on their learning journey— regardless of whether they are on, above, or below their grade level.

Since MAP Growth tests provide immediate and accurate information about your child's learning, it's easy for teachers to identify students with similar scores in similar skills and topics and then plan instruction accordingly.

MAP Growth reports also provide typical growth data for students in the same grade and subject with the same starting performance level. Each school year, students in grades K-8 take the tests in Fall, Winter and Spring testing windows. Following each testing period, you will receive a Family Report showing a summary of how your child is performing academically.



The extra days in the calendar will assist staff in conducting a thorough self-study. The process of continuous improvement is rigorous. It is exceedingly important that a through self-study yield a strategic plan which propels St. Dominic School into the future.
