

Scholarships will be awarded ranging from \$500 to \$3000 and will be sent directly to the preschool to pay for tuition.

- Applications will be accepted for the 2025-2026 school year beginning November 1, 2024.
 - Scholarships are offered on a rolling basis until all funds have been awarded.
 - You are eligible to apply if:
 - Your child will be attending an eligible Catholic preschool;
 - Your child will be in their last year of preschool in 2025-2026 and
 - Your family is middle-income.
