
Drop off cash or a check at the school office.

# Check out this good news!!!

### Kindergarten

- 40% of students who were high risk in letter naming fluency in the fall are no longer high risk in the winter
- 91% of students are testing at or above benchmark in letter sound fluency

#### 1st Grade:

- 75% of students are reading fluently at or above grade level
- 0% of students are at high risk in their reading fluency
- Students doubled their words per minute from fall to winter

### 2nd Grade:

All students increased their Oral

with Mass/Ashes at church. This is a regular school Mass but also Ash Wednesday Mass for St. Dominic Parish.

In addition to a focus Prayer, no-Meat Fridays and days of Fasting as well as works of love and service, students will also engage in Stations of the Cross.

- Grades PreSchool-Grade 1 will engage in Stations of the Cross at School.
- Grades 2-8 will go to church on Fridays at 1:45 PM for Stations of the Cross.

Reading Fluency (reading speed and accuracy) by 25 wpm from fall to winter

### 3rd Grade:

- 83% of students are at or above grade level for Oral Reading Fluency (reading speed and accuracy)
- Students who were below grade level increased their Oral Reading Fluency by 40 wpm

71% of students K-3 are at or above grade level as of January 2025...keep in mind, the national average is that only 40% of students are reading at grade level! Way to go St. Dominic students!
