

The Problem

The governor's proposed budget, released in January 2025, **defunds students by eliminating nonpublic pupil aid** that supports each student with funding for testing, textbooks, counseling, nursing, and busing.

The governor is backing away from the state's **commitment to fund essential services for all students**, not just those who attend his preferred provider.

The Solution

Protect these investments in nonpublic pupil aid and nonpublic transportation aid from harmful cuts.

Important update on nonpublic pupil aid


Unfortunately, Governor Tim Walz has doubled down on his proposal to eliminate nonpublic pupil education aid and transportation aid in his <u>updated</u> <u>budget released March 21</u>. If passed, Gov. Walz's budget would cut more than \$100 million in aid over two years. These cuts would go into effect on July 1.

Also, legislation has recently been introduced in the House (H.F. 2433) and Senate (S.F. 2255) to make these harmful cuts and includes a repeal of statutes that protect this funding in Minnesota law. There is a hearing for this legislation in the House Education Finance Committee on March 27, and a hearing in the Senate Education Finance Committee could also occur soon.

Given these serious developments, we ask that you keep connecting with your elected officials and sharing resources with school families to advocate against this elimination. Your partnership will make a big difference for our students and their families. The following resources will help you advocate and communicate the importance of nonpublic pupil aid to policymakers.






