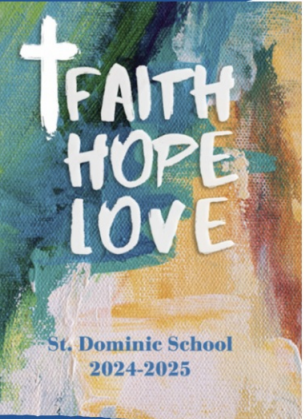

ADVOCACY DAY AND RALLY FOR NONPUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS



Rally for Non-Public Education is Wednesday, May 7th at the MN State Capital.

WHAT:

Rally and Advocacy Day co-sponsored by the Minnesota Catholic Conference and MINNDEPENDENT to Stop Cuts of \$100 million in nonpublic school student aid.

WHO:

All are welcome to attend--registration is strongly recommended.

WHEN:

Rally on Wednesday, May 7 at 1:30 pm in the Capitol Rotunda; Advocacy Day from 9am-4:30pm.

WHY:

These harmful cuts to students are moving forward in the Legislative process. The cuts are currently being proposed by Governor Walz and Senate Democrats, who have included the cuts in their K-12 education finance bill.

HOW:

By showing up at the Capitol, rallying with others, and connecting with your legislators you will make an impact in ensuring these harmful cuts are removed from budget talks and that these important aids are preserved for future students.
