



Fall 2025 AimsWeb Results – A Strong Start!

We are proud to share our Fall 2025 AimsWeb literacy data as we continue to support students through evidence-based instruction and small-group interventions aligned to Groves Literacy Partnerships. Our Saints are off to an incredibly strong start this school year!

Oral Reading Fluency (ORF) – Grades 1-3

- 92% of 1st graders at/above benchmark
- 62% of 2nd graders at/above benchmark
- 88% of 3rd graders at/above benchmark
- Combined: 83% of all 1st-3rd graders at/above grade level
- Students are developing strong decoding and reading accuracy skills to support comprehension and lifelong literacy!

Kindergarten Performance

- 93% at or above grade level in Letter Name Fluency (LNF)
- 100% at or above grade level in Letter Sound Fluency (LSF)
- Kindergarteners are building a firm foundation for early reading success!
