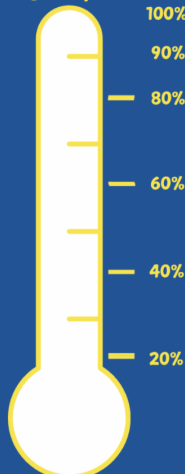

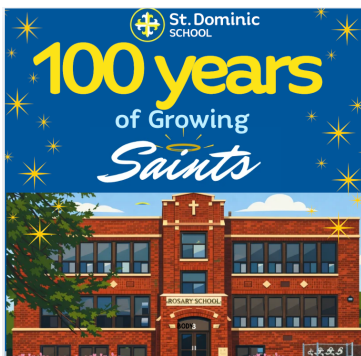

Sanctuary after identifying themselves and their purpose for being at church.

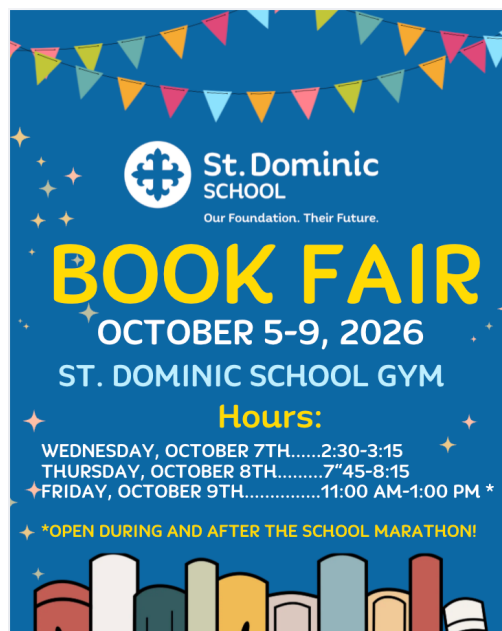
- These enhanced efforts are in place to ensure our students' safety.

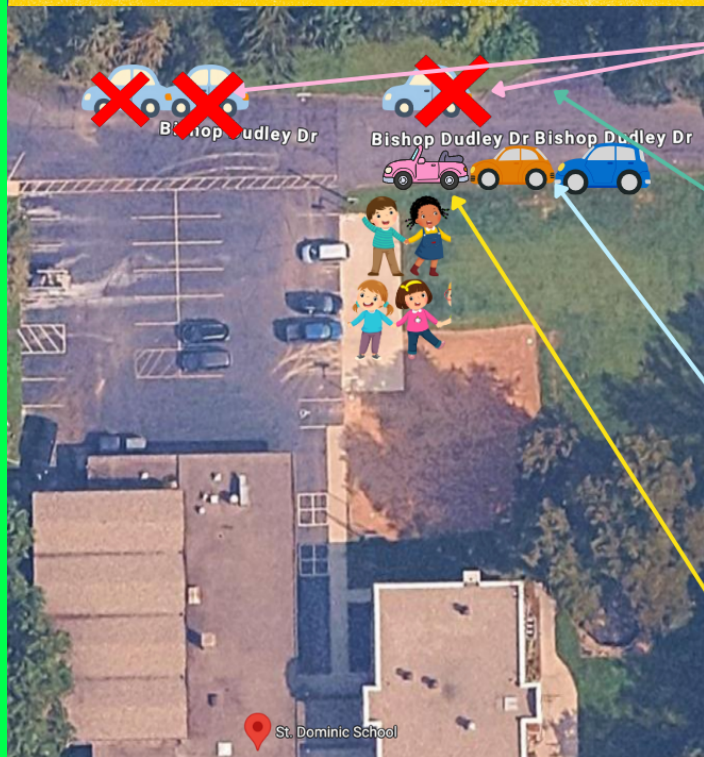

Student Drop-off and Pick up



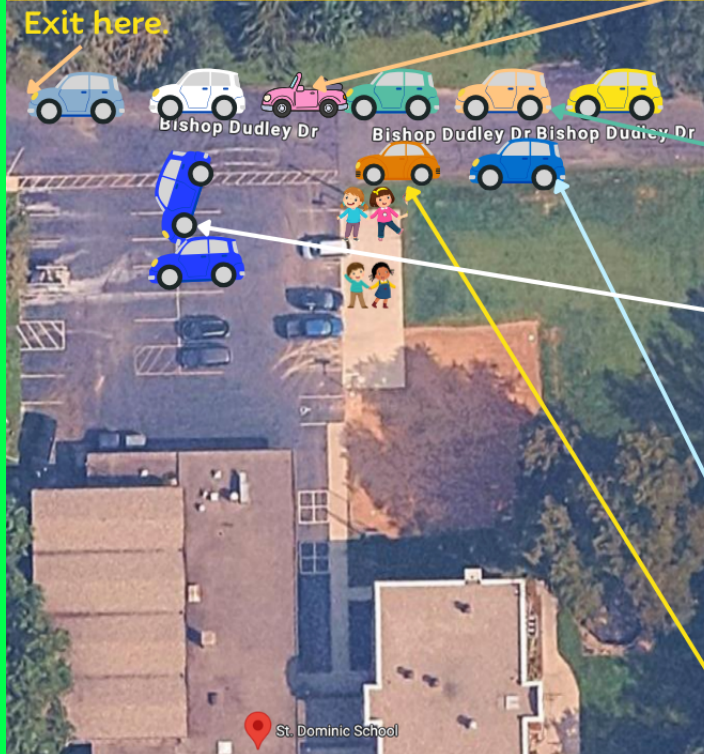
Do not park here and drop off and pick up
